

Troop 70 2018 Overview

2018 has been another year of fun and excitement for the Scouts of Troop 70! We have had a variety of activities scheduled to meet the needs of the boys and our community. Here are some of the facts and figures that describe Troop 70:

- honored five Scouts for achieving the rank of Eagle Scout.
- Eagle service projects provided fleece blankets for addicted babies, renovated the Little League dugout, constructed an information kiosk at Carnegie Hall, constructed a soccer practice wall at EGMS, and produced an opiod-awareness video for adolescents.
- * removed over 500 pounds of the invasive species Garlic Mustard from Kates Mountain.

- 15 Scouts and leaders will be attending the Haarlem Jamborette in the Netherlands in July.
